

Message from the Chairman

It's now been 20 years that the Chaleur Regional Hospital Foundation has been accomplishing its mission for the health of the community. Over the years, it has built its credibility and won over the confidence of those who are essential in attaining its mission: its donors and partners. This long history of engagement and generosity has enabled the Foundation to support the Chaleur Regional Hospital in the realization of numerous vital projects. Thanks to you, over 20 years, more than 8 million dollars have been invested in the support of improvements to health care close to home.

This year, it's a total of \$675,616 that has been given to the Chaleur Regional Hospital to help accomplish projects related to over 25 different sectors grouped in the following manner:

63.4% for the fight against cancer: **\$428,254**

33.0% for patient care: **\$222,946**

2.3% for rehabilitation services: **\$15,866**


1.3% for personnel: **\$8,550**

In the list of main projects financed by the Foundation, we have to mention the acquisition of a new Digital mammography machine which is the result of a three year partnership with CKLE 92,9 FM and the Chaleur and Acadian Peninsula communities.
