This year, the equipment targeted by the Roses Radiothon is a surgical table for Ambulatory Care at the Chaleur Regional Hospital. All minor operations are currently performed on stretchers. The addition of this table will make patients more comfortable during procedures, provide a safe environment.

This type of table will continue to serve as specialized equipment for complex cases (e.g. skin cancer treatments) in several specialties. It should help reduce the operating room waiting lists and allow some cancers to be treated more quickly.

## What is ambulatory care?

This involves a broad range of quality care. Patients receiving ambulatory care services are not hospitalized. They undergo diagnostic tests, receive regular treatments, or have medical appointments requiring specialized equipment. In 2014-2015, 65,469 consultations took place at the Ambulatory Care Department of the Chaleur Regional Hospital.

## Did you know that ...

- $\bullet$  Chaleur Region: 100 % of the funds raised will go toward the Roses Radiothon
- Acadian Peninsuls: 20 % of the funds raised on the Acadian Peninsula will go toward the Roses Radiothon
  and 80% of the funds raised will go toward meeting the needs targeted by the annual campaigns of the three
  foundations in the peninsula
- Together, we have raised \$1,513,135 toward the purchase of equipment enhancing the screening and treatment of certain cancers at the Chaleur Regional Hospital and meeting needs within the facilities on the Acadian Peninsula.
